or

performing in a harmonious,

agreeable, and congenial combination with

another or others...”



Five Fingers of Compatibility



Five Fingers of Compatibility

1. Spiritual



Spiritual Compatibility

- Am I spiritually compatible with the one I am dating or with whom I am in a serious relationship with?
- Is he a Christian? (2 Corinthians 6:14-16)
- Is he active with his faith? Is he growing spiritually?
- Does he challenge you to grow in relationship with God? (Proverbs 27:17)
- Does he have similar convictions and beliefs about God? (Philippians 2:2)
- Are you both headed in the same direction spiritually?



Spiritual Compatibility

- Is he a Christian? (2 Corinthians 6:14-16)

Do not be unequally yoked with unbelievers. For what partnership has righteousness with lawlessness? Or what fellowship has light with darkness? Or what does a believer have in common with an unbeliever?...

- Does he challenge you to grow in relationship with God? (Proverbs 27:17)

As iron sharpens iron, so a friend sharpens a friend.

- Does he have similar convictions and beliefs about God? (Philippians 2:2)

Then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind.

Intellectual Compatibility

- Do you engage in conversations and communicate well with one another?
- Is he interested in your opinions?
- Do you both occasionally ask each other for advice?
- Does he stimulate or challenge your thinking in a positive way. And do you do the same with him?
(Hebrews 10:24)
- Are you able to discuss issues that deal with family, friends, money, career, current issues, even politics?



Intellectual Compatibility

- Does he stimulate or challenge your thinking in a positive way. And do you do the same with him?

(Hebrews 10:24)

Social Compatibility

- Do you both have similar interests, hobbies, recreational and social activities?
- Are you supportive of his interests and activities even though you do not participate or are actively involved with them?
- Do you enjoy and feel comfortable around his friends? Does he feel the same around yours?
(Romans 12:16)
- Do you both enjoy doing things together?



Social Compatibility

- Do you enjoy and feel comfortable around his friends? Does he feel the same around yours?

Emotional Compatibility

But encourage one another day after day, as long as it is still called "Today," so that none of you will be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.



Emotional Compatibility

- Does he show sensitivity, compassion, and patience toward you or is he emotionally disengaged?

(1 Peter 3:7)

In a similar way, you husbands must live with your wives in an understanding manner, as with a most delicate partner. Honor them as heirs with you of the gracious gift of life, so that nothing may interfere with your prayers.



Emotional Compatibility

- Is he given to anger, moody? Does he become depressed frequently?

(Proverbs 22:24-25)

*“Do not make friends with an angry man,
and do not associate with a hot-tempered man,
or you may learn his ways
and entangle yourself in a snare.”*



Emotional Compatibility

- Is he willing to talk out problems in your relationship and not be afraid of confrontation?
- Is he a good listener? (James 1:19)
- Is he able to humble himself and apologize when he has been wrong? (James 4:10)
- Is he a forgiving person? Are you? (Ephesians 4:32)



Emotional Compatibility

Is he a good listener? (James 1:19)

This you know, my beloved brethren. But everyone must be quick to hear, slow to speak and slow to anger;

Is he able to humble himself and apologize when he has been wrong? (James 4:10)

Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you.

Is he a forgiving person? Are you? (Ephesians 4:32)

Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.

Physical Compatibility

- Is he physically challenged or handicapped in some way?
- Is he able to produce children?
- Is he impotent or unable to have sex?
- Does he carry STDs ; Herpes? Hepatitis C?
- Are you physically attracted to him? And is he to you?



Physical Compatibility

- Physical union is sanctioned by God only in a marriage relationship.
(Mark 10:7-9 ; 1 Corinthians 7:2-6)
- Physical intimacy is more than just having sex it can involve non-sexual affirmations of affection.
- Does he show physical affection in non-sexual ways? Ex: holding hands, kissing, cuddling?



Physical Compatibility

- Physical union is sanctioned by God only in a marriage relationship.

(Mark 10:7-9)

For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh. So they are no longer two, but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, let man not separate.



Physical Compatibility

- Physical union is sanctioned by God only in a marriage relationship.

(1 Corinthians 7:2)

But since sexual immorality is occurring, each man should have sexual relations with his own wife, and each woman with her own husband.
